Speakers

Dr. Craig C. Humber, B.Sc, M.Sc, DMD, OMFS, FRCD(C) – Craig is originally from Northern Ontario and completed a B.Sc (Chem) and M.Sc (Chem) at the University of Guelph. After completing a degree at the University of Saskatchewan, he worked for Health Canada as a rural dentist in remote northern Saskatchewan communities. He then completed a GPR residency at UBC, Vancouver General Hospital, and his Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery training with the University Health Network at the University of Toronto. During his OMFS training, Craig also completed a second M.Sc in the area of bone biology and reconstruction. He now resides in Saskatoon with his wife and 3 children, where he maintains a full private practice. Craig is also a part-time instructor at the University of Saskatchewan College of Dentistry.

Mr. Ryan Dueck, B.Sc (Kin), BMR (OT), M.Sc (Biomechanics) – Ryan is originally from Lloydminster and completed a B.Sc in Kinesiology at the University of Saskatchewan, followed by a BMR (Bachelor of Medical Rehabilitation) at the University of Manitoba, graduating in 2002. He subsequently completed a M.Sc in Biomechanics at the University of Saskatchewan. Ryan has been practicing in occupational therapy with a focus on musculoskeletal rehabilitation and ergonomic intervention, for the past 10 years. He operates his own business, iPM Occupational Therapy, and is the Saskatchewan representative for the Canadian Association of Ergonomists. Ryan has done recently research on ergonomics in the dental setting and has provided consultation to dental staff directly in the dental operator setting. Ryan resides in Saskatoon with his wife and 3 children.

Course Outline: Dental Workers experience a high prevalence of musculoskeletal disorders and are exposed to many risk factors associated with muscle/joint pain such as repetition, static/awkward postures, and high pinch forces. Ryan’s seminar will focus on research –based evidence to explain causes of repetitive strain injuries, identify physical and psychological risk factors in dental work and develop ergonomic strategies for preventing muscle/joint problems. Real examples using video and photo analysis will be presented to assist in identifying common problems and applying strategies. This course will benefit anyone working in the dental setting and will utilize video analysis of real dental office settings, as well a dental chair and ergonomic operator and assistant chairs for hands-on demonstration purposes.
